

The following is the Index of Arabs issued by the British Consulate in Batavia in 1919 and renewed periodically up till 1920. Currently, the original copy held by the Asia, Pacific and Africa Collections in the British Library ([IOR/R/20/A/1409](#)) is in an advanced state of decay. Hence, parts of the document are either missing or illegible. It is reproduced here in the hope that the contents of the document would not be lost to researchers.

From 1915 to 1920, several typed memos with the names and short biographies of various Arab individuals based in the Malay Archipelago suspected of harbouring anti-British, pan-Islamic sentiments were continuously circulated amongst the Foreign Office in London and British colonial governments. The memos emanating from the British Consulate in Batavia were intended to warn other colonial officials in the British Empire about Arab Muslims based in the Netherlands Indies who were thought to have been influenced by German, Ottoman and later, Turkish propaganda during the First World War and its immediate aftermath. These memos culminated in the Index of Arabs which were circulated in its entirety amongst various agencies, including British Straits Settlements Government in Singapore, the British Consulate-General in Batavia as well as the Aden Protectorate.

The Index was accompanied by a letter from British Consul-General in Batavia, W.N. Dunn, who supervised the creation of the Index. The Index features the names of 7 societies and 240 individuals arranged by alphabetical order. The aim of the British Consulate-General in Batavia in creating the Index was two-pronged: to identify pro-British Arabs who might be of service to colonial governments, as well as anti-British Arabs in order to deny them access to the ports of Singapore, British India and the Aden Protectorate.¹ Although officially known as the 'Index of Arabs,' it was sometimes referred to as 'Batavia List of Suspect Arabs,' and more often as 'List of Dangerous Arabs' in British colonial correspondence. The main draft dated 27th September 1919 is reproduced here. Entries were continually added to the main list till the 1920 on slips of paper which were attached to this original document. At least three more separate short lists of Arabs supplemented the main Index.²

Each entry lists the full name of the individual, his current age, place of birth, current location, occupation and political allegiances with regards to Britain, Germany, Turkey and the two Sultans of Hadhramaut.³ Some entries also include the individual's language capabilities, list of publications and travel history. Occasionally, a list of the individual's coterie of friends and relations mentioned elsewhere in the Index was also noted.

The following notations are used:

A few societies and publications are mentioned in the Index.

Societies

1. Al Irsjad Society

Established in Batavia about 1913.

Alleged object: to spread Islamic Teachings

Actual object: To struggle for equality with Saids (Highest class of Arabs who claim descent from the Prophet Muhammad)

Carries out German and Turkish propaganda. Members consist of low class Arabs. Manggoesj being the leader under:- Manggoesj. Shaikh Oemar bin Yoesoef.

Receives strong support from the German and Turkish General and also encouragement from local authorities. Branches and schools established in the following schools in Java:- Sourabaya, Cheribon, Tegal, Pekalongan, and Boeminjoe. Earnest endeavours to introduce [...] in the Straits Settlements and the Malay Peninsula. Very dangerous society.

2. Djamiat Alwiyyin Wa-Ansarihim

Name of an Arab society established in Sourabaya in July 1919.

(Society of the descendants of the Prophet Mohamed and their supporters). Actively pro-British. Branch established in Batavia 29th August 1919.

3. Djamiat Geir

Name of a Muslim Society majority of members being Arabs both of high and low subjects: to ameliorate the educational, moral and [...] status of the general Muslim community. Maintains schools under the Society's name, one in Batavia the other in Buitenzorg. Pro-British and strong anti-Al-Irsjad.

4. Mohamadiyah Society

Founded in 1912, in Djocjakarta, Java. Alleged objects some of those of Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Moehamad. Connected with Central Java revolutionary movements and also those of the Al-Irsjad from whose active members it recently received liberal donations.

5. Oetoesan Islam

(Messenger of Islam). A weekly paper in Sourabaya. Contents Religions and politics. Very strongly pro-German and pro-Turkish. Published by "Drukkerij Al-Hilal" meaning (the Crescent Press), of which the editor himself is the proprietor.

6. Swara Ra'jat

Weekly organ in Sourabaya of the Indische Social Democratische Vereeniging.

7. Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Mohamad.

Name of a society, which means "the army of the blessed Prophet Mohamad." Established in Sourabaya in January 1918. Alleged objects: to protect the Islamic Religion.

To preach the religion as widely as possible in the Dutch East Indies.

To start active propaganda against Christian missionaries.

The leader is Said Mohamad Saleh Shawashi.

Individuals

1. Ahmad. Sjech Awad bin Mohamed.

Born and resident at Cheribon. Age 30. Proprietor of small auto garage. A very active supporter of Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

2. Abbad. Sjech Said bin Mohamed.

Born and resident at Cheribon. Money lender. Committee member of Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

3. Abdoelaziz. Syed Ahmad bin.

Born Batavia. Age about 60. Resident at Tangerang, near Batavia. Brick merchant and owner of house property. Fiercely anti-British and actively pro-German and pro-Turkish. Brother-in-law of Syed Abdullah bin Aloeï Alatas.

4. Abdoelhamid. Shaikh Mohamad.

Born Sudan. Age about 35. Resident Batavia. Formerly teacher of Djamiat Geir School. Went to Singapore about middle <1917> To apply for pass to proceed to Cairo but was refused. At present a general trader travelling over Java.

5. Abdoel-Maboed. Said Abdullah bin.

Born Mecca. Of Baghdad origin. Age about 65. Address Djatti Weltevreden, (Batavia). Occupation house property and money-lending. Extremely pro-Turkish and pro-German. Brother-in-law of Syed Abdullah Alatas.

6. Abdul-Maboed. Syed Saleh.

Born Batavia. Age about 35. Address Djatti, Weltevreden (Batavia). Occupation looking after [...]’s and father-in-law’s house property. Educated in Egypt and England. Rather a quiet man, but not so as far as politics was concerned. Notoriously anti-British and strongly pro-Turkish and pro-German. Son of Said Abdulrahim Abdoel-Maboed, and third son-in-law of Syed Abdullah bin Aloeï Alatas.

7. Aboed, Sjech Salim bin Ahmad.

Born Batavia, Age about 30. Address Pekodjan, Batavia. Produce merchant. Member of Al Irsjad. Frankly anti-British.

8. Aboed. Shaikh Mohamen bin Obeid.

Born Hadramaut. Age 35. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Teacher Al Irsjad School, Batavia. Anti-British. As active and fierce as the Sudanese Ahmad Soerkati. Director of the School.

9. AbdoelFadel. Mohammad, alias Shaikh Soerkati.

About 30. Born and educated in Sudan. Teacher in Al Irsjad School, Sourabaya. Brother of Shaikh Ahmad Soerkati.

10. Aldjoefri. Syed Edroes.

Resident Semarang (Formerly Pekalongan). General merchant. Schoolmaster. Close friend of Mohamed bin Salim Baraja, Mohamed bin Hashim of Pekalongan. Formerly pro-German in his talks. Has

come round over Said-Shaikh question. Rather weak and capable of being used as a tool. Talks far too much and cannot be trusted. Very friendly with many leading natives of Semarang and is an important man in their new Islam School. Learning [...]

11. Alaidroes. Said Abdullah bin Ali.

Born Hadramaut. Age about 50. Address Pangerang near Batavia. Occupation brick merchant and house property. Second son-in law of Syed Abdullah bin Aloe Alatas. Very keenly interested in spreading all sorts of rumours against the Sheriff of Mecca, who he publicly denounces as a non-Muslim as having betrayed Turkey. Actively working against the Batavia Arab Committee of the King's fund for the Disabled. Bo[...] of his many German friends. A very [...] anti-British preacher.

12. Alaidroes. Said Abdullah bin [...]

Born Hadramaut. Age about 65. Address Petamboeran. Weltevreden (Batavia). Coffee and general produce merchant. Strongly pro-German and pro-Turkish, and extremely anti-British and anti Batavia Arab Commitee of the King's Fund for the Disabled.

13. Alaidroes. Said Abdoelkadir bin Hoesin.

Born Hadramaut. Age about 60. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Occupation money-lending and house property. Extremely anti-British, pro-Turkish and pro-German.

14. Alaidroes. Syed Abdoelrahman bin Abdoelkadir.

Born Batavia. Age about 35. Educated in Turkey and Belgium. Speaks Arabic, Turkish and French. Occupation formerly Secretary to the Turkish Consulate General Batavia but now pleader in the District Magistracy. Strongly pro-Turkish and pro-German. Notoriously anti-British.

15. Alakib. Sheik Mohamed.

Born Sudan. Address Djatti, Weltvreden (Batavia). Age about 35. Teacher Al-Irsjad School, Batavia.

16. Alameri. Shaikh Amir bin Hoewe [...] Seif bin Tebe.

Born Hadramaut. Age <43>. Address: Buitenzorg. Batik merchant and money-lender. Member of the Al-Irsjad. Strongly anti-British.

17. Al Amoedi. Shaikh Abdullah Bajammah.

Resident Sourabaya. 25 years. Religious teacher. Age 50. Born Gaiden, Hadhramaut, Mohamedan. Nominated in Al-irsjad's pamphlet of 22.7.19. Probably one of the original founders of Al-Irsjad movement in Sourabaya.

18. Al-Amoedi. Shaikh Abdullah bin Saeid <Bahmed>

Expected Sourabaya via Singapore. Was in Sourabaya 11 years ago. Sarong merchant with his nephew Oesman bin Mohamad Al-Amoedi. Age 50. Born Hesar (Dhofa district). Member (Al-Irsjad).

19. Al-Amoedi. Shaik Oesman bin Mohamad.

Resident Sourabaya 30 years. Piece-goods merchant. Age 45. [...] Hadramaut. Mohamedan. Anti-British.

20. Al-Amoedi. Shaikh Ahmad bin Oesan [...] Born Dufah. Hadramaut. In [...], near Sourabaya. Batik Trader. Notorious [...] preacher. Cousin of Shai [...] Mohamad Almoedi. Sourabaya [...] Refused visa on <25/10/18>

21. Al-Almoedi. Shaikh Mohamad A[...] bin Oemar. Age 45. Born in Doan, Hadramaut. Came to Java from the Hadramaut about 2 months. Address in Kampong Arampil, sourabaya, where he stayed with his cousin Shaikh Mohamed bin Said Alam... His passport no. 5141 D/4-1-1920 [...] issued [...] the Sultan of [...] extremely anti-British. Has [...] about Fl. 30,000 from Almoedi and other rich members of the Almoedi family, for the purpose of establishing a school under the name of Al-Irsjad in the Hadramaut and also for [...] trouble with the Alkaity through the [...] the notorious chief Bin [...] Saleh bin Mohamed who has under this influence the following tribes:- 1) al Balubeid 2) Al-Abdaiyeen 3) Al-Basoweidan. Applied for visa to proceed to the Hadramaut via Aden by the S.S. "Garoet" on 2nd M[...]1920 which was granted. Did not sail by the S.S. Garoet as he intended for he received a telegram instructing him to return to Sourabaya and to hand the money F. 30,000. To Shaik Abdullah bin Hosain Alamudi who obtained a visa from this office no. 12409 dated 26/4/1920 and sailed by the S.S. Garoet. Nothing was previously known against Shaikh Abdullah bin Hussain Alamudi.

22. Alatas. Shaikh Abdullah bin Hosain. See under Alamudi, Shaikh Mohamad bin Oemar.

23. Alatas. Syed Abdullah bin <Aloei> Born Batavia. Age about 70. One of wealthiest Arabs in Batavia. Occupation house property. Educated in Java and Mecca. Been to Hadramaut, Palestine, Turkey, Egypt, British India, Straits Settlements and Australia. Personal acquaintance with several Turkish ex-ministers. Egypt notables Established a school[...] Mu[...] children in 1912 which was closed entirely [...]. Master of Arabic and Malay [...] languages [...]ly interested in Islamic propaganda [...] an intimate friend of Cr. S. Hurgronje with whom he studied Islamic teachings and laws in Mecca. Has four sons all educated in Egypt and Europe. P.T.O.

in-law of Syed Abdullah bin aloei Alatas. Notoriously anti-British
and actively pro-German and pro-Turkish. Personally acquainted
with many Germans. Often seen at German jewellery shop at G.
Stourwalk.

25. Alatas. Syed Aidroes bin Saleh.
Born Pekalongan. Age about 30. Address Djatti, Weltevreden
(Batavia). [...] trader. Illiterate. Apparently not interested in
politics. Fourth son-in-law of Syed Abdullah bin Aloei Alatas.

26. Alatas. Syed Hashim bin Abdullah.
Born Batavia. Address: Djatti, Weltevreden (Batavia). Educated in
Egypt, Turkey, France, Belgium. Speaks French, Turkish, and Arabic
fluently, a little dutch and English. Profession: Agriculturist.
Formerly owner of rubber plantation at Lengkong. [...] Java, which
was sold to the [...] in 1918 for Fl. 300,000. At present [...]
notoriously anti-British and pro-German and pro-Turkish. Left for
Holland <in> July 1919. Third son of Syed Abdullah Aloei Alatas.

27. Alatas. Syed Hamzah bin Aboebakar.
Born Batavia. Age about 23. Address Petamboeran, Weltevreden,
(Batavia). Educated in Egypt. Speaks English. Occupation, looking
after father's house property awnd also money-lending. Son of Said
Aboebakar bin Abdullah Alatas. As mischievous as his younger
brother Syed Muhammad bin Aboebakar Alatas.

28. Alatas. Syed Ismail bin Abdullah.
Born Batavia. Address Djatti, Weltevreden (Batavia) Age about 26.
Educated in Egypt, Holland and England. Studied Arabic in Cairo.
Commerce in Birmingham; Dutch French and German in Holland.
Extensive travels Europe. Member of certain political society in
Switzerland where he was connected with a pamphleteer L.F. Hoffman
in the pay of the Germans. Was also in correspondence with an
Egyptian nationalist. In 1917 returned to Java. On way rumoured to
have been examined Singapore, consequence report re Europe
associates. Employed Niederer & Co. Batavia (pro-German firm)
during 1917. Nominated member Volksraad. Disliked by the Saids on
account of his adherence to shaikh Oembar bin Yoesoef Manggoesj.
Is on intimate terms with high Dutch officials. Now manager and
partner Barakah Trading Company [...] a firm established 1919 whose
[...] the youngest supporters of Al-Irsjad [...] pro-German and
frankly anti-British. Youngest son of Syed Abdullah bin Aloei

29. Alatas. Syed Mohamad bin Abdullah.
Born Batavia. Address Djatti, Weltevreden (Batavia). Age about 44.
Profession mining engineer. Educated in Egypt, Turkey, France,
Belgium and England. Speaks Arabic Turkish French and English
fluently. A little Dutch Spanish Italian German. Partner of [...]

Hachim (Alatas) & Co. Frankly anti-British, pro-German. Second son of Syed Abdullah Alatas.

30. Alatas. Syed Mohamad bin Aboebakar.
Born Batavia. Age about 21. Address Petamboeran, Weltevreden (Batavia) Educated in Egypt. Speaks English. Occupation general trade and money-lending. Refused visa for Singapore in April 1919. Actively pro-German and pro-Turkish. A reckless anti-British preacher. Son of Said Aboebakar bin Abdullah Alatas.

31. Alatas. Syed Oemar bin Aloei.
Born Batavia. Age about 45. Address Tanah Abang. Weltevreden (Batavia) Educated in Constantinople where he studied law and French. Formerly owner of agricultural land known as Pondok Betong, near Batavia which was sold to the Government for Fl. 650,000. Member of Al Irsjad. Extremely anti-British, pro-German and pro-Turkish. Younger brother of Syed Abdullah bin Aloei Alatas.

32. Alatas. Syed Osman bin Abdullah.
Born Batavia. Age about 47. Profession Medical. Educated in Egypt Turkey and France. Almost all life spent in Turkey. And at present is employed as [...] in a certain Government school. Joined Turkish Red Crescent during the Balkan Wars. Eldest son [...] of Syed Abdullah bin Aloei Alatas.

33. Alatas. Syed Saleh bin Mohamad.
Born Pekalongan. Java. Age about 30. Address Djatti, Weltevreden (Batavia) Trades in bricks [...] timber &c. Fiercely anti-British and strongly pro-German and pro-Turkish. Son-in-law of Abdoel-Maboed.

34. Albakeri. Shaikh Abdullah bin Hoessin.
Born Hadramaut. Resident Pekalongan. Strong supporter of Al-Irsjad. Pekalongan. Notorious anti-British preacher. Actively pro-German and pro-Turkish.

35. Albakeri. Sjech Hussin bin Nasir.
Born Pekalongan. Age about 22. Educated in Al-Irsjad School, Batavia. Now teacher Al-Irsjad School Sourabaya. Actively pro-German and pro-Turkish. Extremely anti-British.
Additional information - Said to have been present at private gatherings of Sarikat Islam and of Javanese Hadjis from Djokjakarta held as preliminary to a public meeting which took place at Pekalongan on August 6th 1920, for the purpose of protesting against the treatment of Turkey over the Khilafat question.

36. Albakeri. Sjech Nasir bin Abdullah.
Born Tegal (Java) Age about 40. Resident Pekalongan (Java) Strong supporter Al-Irsjad. Extremely anti-British, actively pro-German and pro-Turkey.

37. Albakeri. Shaikh Saleh bin Abdullah.

Born Hadramaut. Address Pekodjan, Batavia. Also has house in Buitenzorg. One of the richest Arabs in Java. Owns land and houses in Batavia and Tegal (Java). Personal acquaintance of almost every German in Batavia [...] in politics, Manggoesj's [...] strongest supporters of [...] anti-British.

38. Albakeri, Shaikh Salim bin Saleh bin Abdullah.
Born Hadramaut. Address Pekalongan. Member Al-Irsjad. Extremely anti-British. Pro-German and pro-Turkish.

39. Albakeri. Shaikh Asad bin Racis (Alkathiri)
Born Hadramaut. Age about 25. Address Keboen Djeroek, Batavia. Educated in Al-Irsjad school. Batavia, of which now a teacher. Openly anti-British.

40. Aldjoefrie. Syed Achmad bin Zein.
Resident Grisse 10 years. Occupation house property. Born Grisse [...] went with father to Mecca as a child. Prepared and accompanied former expedition of 5 Germans who attempted to reach Hadramaut. Friend of Shawashi. Concerned in second attempt to ship Germans to Hadramaut.

41. Aldjoefrie. Syed Aloewi bin Zein.
Resident Grisse 15 years. Occupation house property. Age 35. Born Grisse. Mohamedan. Brother of Syed Achmad bin Zein Aldjoefrie. Father deceased. Went with father to Mecca as a child. Friend of Shawashi. Concerned in second attempt to ship Germans [...]

42. Alhabbani. Shaikh Halim bin Mohamad.
Born Hadramaut. Address Pekodjan, Batavia. Age about 40. Member Al-Irsjad. Always preaches against the British before a small gathering held in the house of Ali bin Saeid Bin-Maghief, Pekodjan, Batavia.

43. Alhaddadi. Shaikh Nadji bin Ali.
Born Hadramaut, Resident Tegal. Member Al-Irsjad, Tegal Java. Recklessly anti-British. Extremely pro-German and pro-Turkish.

44. Al-Hashimi. Mohamed bin Osman.
A native of Tunis and a French protégé. Is an able Arab journalist, who at one time did useful propaganda work for us in return for pay. Later, he became editor of Al-Irsjad's journal Assalam, which survived one issue only and contained articles directed against the British and the King of the Hedjaz. According to one authority he states that he had been forced to write the articles by Al-Irsjad leaders. Al-Hashimi has, however denied this to the H.M. Consul-General and accepted full responsibility for the articles; he has alleged that his dismissal from the post of editor was due to his writing them. Very probably, he was threatened or bribed by Al-Irsjad.
Al-Irsjad to assume responsibility for the articles which are said to have displeased the moderates and to have forced the heads of

Society to replace Assalam by another newspaper known as Al-Irsjad" under a news editor.

Al Hashimi is now ostensibly a staunch supporter of Al-Irsjad, which he declares to be an innocent and political organisation. He is to be regarded as a venal personage who is ready to sell his pen to whichever side will pay him most for it.

45. Alja-Eidi. Shaikh Mussalam bin Salim bin Halabi.
Born Hadramaut. Resident Pekalongan (Java). Member, Al-Irsjad, Pekalongan. Extremely anti-British, pro-German, and pro-Turkish.

46. Alkathiri. Sjech Saeid bin Saleh.
Born and Resident at Pekalongan. Batik trader. Member, Al-Irsjad. Anti-British, pro-German and pro-Turkish.

47. Alkathiri. Shaikh <Yislan> bin <Oemarembardar>
Born Hadramaut. Age 42, Resident Cheribon. Money-lender. Member, Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

48. Alkhaiyat. Yusoff.
Teacher in Al-Irsjad School in Sourabaya, for which post he was recommended by BANAWI, Shaikh Mohamed. Reported to be an Arab from Mecca, and a member of the Young Turk Party (Party of Union and Progress).

49. Alkubish. Shaikh Obeid bin Faraj. (Alkathiri)
Born Hadramaut. Age about 50. Address Keboen Djeroek, Batavia. Batik trader. Notoriously anti-British. Son a teacher in the Al-Irsjad School, Batavia. Active member Al-Irsjad.

50. Almahdar. Said Aloewi bin Mohamad.
Resident Bondowose, Java, 15 years. Runs business for his father Said Mohamad Almahdar. Age 27. Born Al-Goeweri, Hadramaut. Mohamedan.

51. Almahdar. Said Mohamad.
Resident Bondowese, Java, 25/30 years. Piece-goods merchant but not active. Religious teacher. Age 58. Born Al-Goeweri, Hadramaut. Very highly revered religious teacher, commanding immense respect. Most imposing presence [...] great natural dignity. Head of Alawiyin Wa-ansarihim.

52. Almasri. Ahmad.
Born and resident Cheribon. Java. Age 49. No special occupation. Member Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

53. Almoesali, Hamid.
Born Mecca. Arrived in Batavia from Mecca in January 1919 and spread all sorts of false tales against the sheriff of Mecca. Stays in Djatti, Weltevreden (Batavia) with cousin Said Abdullah bin Abdoel-Maboed.

54. Alshishli. Shaikh Ali bin Mohamad.

Resident Sourabaya. 10 years. Born Yemen, Mohamedan. Ledaer Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Mohamed.

Additional Information: changed his politics and came over to the Saids in July <1919>

55. Althikah. Hassan Abu Ali.

Born Hadramaut. Age about 30. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Member Al-Irsjad. Frankly anti-British.

156. Bin Badar (Al Kathiri) Shaikh Salim bin Oemar.

Address Keboen Djeroek, Batavia. Member Al-Irsjad. Anti-British preacher.

157. Bin-Gahedan. Sjech Ali bin Ahmad.

Born and resident at Cherbon Java. Age 53. Deals in ponies. Member Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

158. Bin-Gahedan. Oemar.

Resident of Pekalongan. Said to have been present at the private gatherings. Mentioned under:- Albakeri Sjech Hoessin bin Nasir.

159. Bin-<Garmoes>. Sjech Salim.

Born Telok Petong Sumatra. Age about 30. Address Pekodjan, Batavia. Batik trader. Member Al-Irsjad. Extremely anti-British. Pro-German and pro-Turkish.

160. Bin Haiderah (Al Kathiri) Shaikh Awad bin Salim.

Born Hadramaut. Age about 40. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Member Al-Irsjad. Frankly anti-British. Pro-German and pro-Turkish.

161. Bin Hantoosh. Shaikh Raeis bin Nasir bin Mohamed.

Born Batavia. Age about 35. Address Sawah Besar. Batik Trader. Member Al-Irsjad. Extremely anti-British. Pro-German and pro-Turkish.

162. Bin-Harharah. Sheikh Abdullah bin Abdulkadir. Born Hadramaut. Age about 50. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. A very active supporter of Ai. The first Arab in Batavia to publish anti-British propaganda. Holds meetings occasionally in own house for same purpose. A very dangerous enemy.

163. Bin-Harharah. Sheikh Abdullah bin Saleh. Resident Sourabaya, 30 years. Piece-goods merchant. Born Sheher, Hadramaut. Leader Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Muhammad. Brother of Oemar bin Saleh bin Harharah. Mohamedan.

164. Bin-Harharah. Shaikh Oemar bin Saleh. Resident Sourabaya, 12 years. Piece-goods merchant. Born Sheher Hadramaut. Leader Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Muhammad. Brother of Shaik Abdullah bin Saleh bin Harharah. Mohamedan.

165. Bin-Marie. Shaikh Salim bin Saleh Belfas. Born Hadramaut. Age 50. Wealthy. Intimate associate of Manggoesj. Strong supporter of Al-Irsjad. Notoriously anti-British.

166. Bin-Hizrah (Al Kathiri) Sjech Mohamad bin Ambarak. Resident Pekalongan. Strong supporter of Al-Irsjad, Extremely anti-British, pro-German, pro-Turkish.

167. Bin-Kuddah (Al Kathiri). Ali. Born Hadramaut. Address Tegal. Member Al-Irsjad, Tegal. Frankly anti-British, pro-German, pro-Turkish.

168. Bin-Maghif. Shaikh Ali bin Saeid. Born Hadramaut. Address Pekodjan, Batavia. See under Salim bin Mohmad Alhabbani.

169. Bin Mahdi (AlKathiri) Shaikh Mohsin bin Jafar. Born Hadramaut. Age about 33. Address Kebon Djeroek, Batavia. A very notorious anti-British preacher. For this purpose gathering held almost every night at own house.

170. Bin-Mahfoed. Shaikh Salim bin Abdullah bin Moesaäd, Born Hadramaut. Age about 40. Address Pesajoeran, Batavia. In Java since boyhood. A district magistracy pleader. Charged with secret circulation of German propaganda among pro-German Arabs. Personal acquaintance with both Turkish and German Consuls General.

171. Bin-Mahfoed. Sheikh Salim bin Ali bin Moesaäd. Born Hadramaut. Formerly in Batavia, now in Cheribon. Strong supporter of Al-Irsjad. Anti-British, strongly pro-German and pro-Turkish.

172. Bin Mahri (Al Kathiri). Azzan.

Of Batavia. Reported in August 1920. To have received a letter from the Kathiri Sultan (Ali bin Mansoer), appealing for help from all Kathiris in Java in the fighting between the Attamimi tribe and the Kathiris in the Hadramaut.

173. Bin Mahri (Al Kathiri). Sjech Abdullah bin Salimin. Born Java, Age about 30. Resident Meester Cornelis (Batavia). Landowner. Strong financial supporter of Al-Irsjad. Heard to have given as donation a house in Petodjo (Batavia) worth Fl. 10,000. Close adherence to Turkish Consul General. Occasionally visit German Consulate. Frankly anti-British.

174. Bin Mahri (Al Kathiri). Shaikh Oemar bin Saleh. Born Hadramaut. Age 45. Physician. Member of Al-Irsjad. Manggoesj's spy. Address Kroekoet, Batavia.

175. Bin-Marie (Al Kathiri). Sheikh Ahmad bin Talib. Born Hadramaut. Age about 35. Business in Sourabaya and Batavia. Connected with German firms. Strongly pro-German and bitterly anti-British. His father and old resident of Singapore but nothing against him known.

176. Bin Masdoef. Shaikh Ali bin Badar bin Aal bin Saeid. Born Hadramaut. Age about 55. Address Kroekoet Batavia. Batik trader. Member Al-Irsjad. Anti-British.

177. Bin-Oan (AlKathiri) Shaikh Ali bin Abdullah. Born Hadramaut. Age about 65. Considered as the richest Arab of Batavia. Illiterate. Address Tjililitan, near Meester Cornelis, Batavia. Went on board the SS Marie when she came to Batavia from German East Africa, with Manggoesj to distribute money among the crew. Contributes liberally to the Irsjad's fund every month. Pro-German and Pro-Turkish.

178. Bin-Saeid (Alkathiri). Sjech Ambarak bin Jafar bin Oemar Belguhoom. Age about 35. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Member Al-Irsjad. Anti-British.

179. Bin Saeid (Alkathiri). Shaikh Awad bin Salim Ali. Born Hadramaut. Age about 35. Address Pasar Baroe, Weltevreden (Batavia). Keeper of two Batik shops, one at Pasar Baroe, and the other at Senen (Weltevreden). Saeid bin Salim Mashabi his partner. Business with Behn Meyer and Co. Manggoesj's intimate associate. Very strongly anti-British and pro-German.

180. Bin Saeid (AlKathiri) Shaikh Mohsin bin Yeslam bin Abdullah bin Mohamad bin Ali. Born Hadramaut. Age about 25. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Member Al-Irsjad. Extremely anti-British.

181. Bin Saeid (AlKathiri). Sheikh Saleh bin Mohamed bin Ali.

Born Hadramaut. Address Meester Cornelis, Batavia. Often seen to visit Dr. Hazeu's house. One of the most reckless and dangerous anti-British preachers.

182. Bin-Semit. Syed Hassan bin Abdulrachman. Resident Surabaya for 45 years. Proprietor "Oetoesan Islam." Age 45. Born Bangkalan. Madoera Island, N.E.I. Never been to Arabia. Leader of Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Mohamad.

183. Bin-Shahab. Said Abdoelmutalib. Born Hadramaut. Age about 32. Address Kampong Djawa Batavia. Manager Sherrifah and Sons. Educated Constantinople. Speaks French fluently. Member Al-Irsjad. Very actively pro-Turkish and pro-German.

184. Bin-Shahab. Syed Ali bin Ahmad. Born Batavia. Age 56. Address Kebon Djeroek, Batavia. Been to Hadramaut several times, also Egypt, Syria, Mecca and Medina. General trader possessed with perfect knowledge of geography of Hadramaut and character of every tribe inhabiting the country. Very keenly interested in politics. Is our first and most reliable and faithful Arab link in Java. Famous for his pro-British activities.

185. Bin-Shahab. Sheikh Awad bin Abdullah. Resident of Solo. Has on several occasions endeavoured to enlist the sympathy of H.M. Consul-General for the Al-Irsjad society. Has denied that there are any anti-British Arabs in Java. Endeavoured to bribe an employee of the Consulate-General into procuring passes to the Hadramaut for two suspect Arabs.

186. Bin-Sahak. Shaikh Saeid bin Salimin. Resident Pekalongan Age 50. Member Al-Irsjad. Actively pro-German and pro-Turkish. A reckless anti-British preacher.

187. Bin-Sunkar. Shaikh Ahmad bin Abdullah bin Salim. Resident Pekalongan. Member Al-Irsjad. A very notorious anti-British preacher. Strong pro-German and pro-Turkish.

188. Bin-Sunkar. Sjech Ali bin Awad. Born Solo, Java. Age about 30. Resident Pekalongan after ten years. Deals in piece goods. Dyes and other materials for Batik manufacture. Considered wealthiest young Arab of that place. Son of Awad bin Sunkar, lieutenant of Arabs in Solo. Very actively pro-German and pro-Turkish. Head of Ai in Pekalongan. Formerly Manggoesj's 3rd man in old pro-Turkish association before birth of Al-Irsjad.

189. Bin-Sunkar. Shaikh Salim bin Ali. Resident Pekalongan. Member of Al-Irsjad. Strongly anti-British. pro-German and pro-Turkish.

190. Bin-Sunkar. Sjech Salim bin Rahman. Born and resident Cheribon, Java.

Age 48. Deals in ponies. Member Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

191. Bin-Talib (Alkathiri). Shaikh Amir bin Abdullah bin Marie. Born Hadramaut. Age about 30. Address Kebon Djeroek. Batavia. Is a very strong supporter of Al-Irsjad. Actively anti-British.

192. Bin-Talib (Alkathiri). Shaikh badar bin Jafar. Born Hadramaut. Resident Pekalongan. Member Al-Irsjad. Frankly Anti-British, pro-German, pro-Turkish.

193. Bin Talib. Shaikh Faraj bin Amir bin Salim. Born Hadramaut. Address Kebon Djeroek. Batavia. Age 40. Anti-British preacher. Member Al-Irsjad.

194. Bin-Talib (AlKathiri). Shaikh Hoseni bin Salim bin Mar-ie. Born Hadramaut. Resident Pekalongan. Member Al Irsjad. Frankly anti-British, pro-German and pro-Turkish.

195. Bin-Talib (AlKathiri). Shaikh Jafar bin Salim bin Mar-ie. Born Hadramaut. Member Al-Irsjad, Anti-British, pro-German and pro-Turkish.

196. Bin-Talib (AlKathiri) Shaikh Rahman bin Awad. Born Hadramaut. Strong member Al-Irsjad. Extremely anti-British, pro-German and pro-Turkish.

197. Bin-Talib (Alkathiri) Sjech Mohamad Ba-Rais. Resident Sourabaya for 25 years. Batik merchant. Age 45. Born Al <Okdhe>, Hadramaut. Mohamedan. Anti-British. Spoke Hindustani. Additional information: Said to have enlisted the sympathy of British Indians at Sourabaya for Al-Irsjad. Of which he is now (August 1920) president of the place named.

198. Bin-Talib (Alkathiri) Roebaya bin Ambarak. Resident Sourabaya for 35 years. Sarong (batik) merchant. Age about 50. Born al Okdhe, Hadramaut, Mohameddan. Leader of Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Mohamad and Al-Irsjad.

199. Bin-Talib (Alkathiri) Sjech Salim bin Abdullah. Resident Pekalongan. Age 35. Member Al-Irsjad. Anti-British pro-German, and pro-Turkish.

200. Bin-Talib (AlKathiri) Shaikh Mohamed bin Ambarak. Born Hadramaut. Age about 50. Brother of Shaikh Roebaya bin Ambarak Bin-Talib, Soerabyaya. Not a member of the Al-Irsjad Society but extremely anti-British and anti al-kaity. Strongly opposed to shaih Salim bin Jaffar bin Talib of Sourabaya who is at present working to form the Alkathiri Society. At a dinner given to him on Friday evenng 5th March 1920 at Kroekoet, Batavia, by Shaikh Ahmad bin Talib Mar-ie bin Talib, he made the following remarks.

"the Alkathiri Society which is to be established in Java will give us no benefit whatsoever. Salim bin Jaffar Bin-Talib is a man

who is not to be trusted as he was one of the man of our own trive that acted as brokers in the sale of Hadramaut to Great Britain. Our native land is no more ours. We are to blame because we did not continud the fight with Alkaity. Reported to be as mischievous as his [...] Roebaya bin Ambarak bin-Talib [...] for a pass to proceed to Hadramaut but was refused on 11/3/20.

201. Bin-Talib (Al Kathiri) Sjech Salim Obeid bin Faraj. Born Batavia. Age about 25. Address Kebon Djeroek, Batavia. Educated in Al-Irsjad school Batavia, of which now a teacher. Strongly anti-British.

202. Bin-Talib (Al Kathiri) Shaikh Mohammad bin Saeid. Born Lesbah, Hadramaut. Age 50. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Batik-trader. 30 years in Batavia. Supporter Al-Irsjad. Fiercely anti-British. Preaches against the British at the Kroekoet Mosque almost every day between 6 p.m. and 7 p.m. Refused visa 21st October 1919.

203. Bin-Talib (Al Kathiri) Shaikh Talib bin Saied bin Jafar. Born Hadramaut. Address Pekalongan. Member Al-Irsjad. Anti-British, pro-German, and pro-Turkish.

204. Bin-Talib (Al Kathiri) Shaikh Khalid bin Mohamad. Born Batavia. Age 25. Address Kroekoet, Batavia. Batik trader. Son of Shaikh Mohamad bin Saeid bin-Talib. As dangerous as his father. Refused visa 21st October 1919.

205. Bin-Tebe (Al Kathiri). Sjech Abdullah bin Saleh bin Oetoeifah. Born Batavia. Address Sawah Besar, Batavia. Age about 30. Member Al-Irsjad. Extremely Anti-British. Gathering at his house almost every night 7 p.m. for the purpose of preaching against the British. A dangerous man.

206. Bin-Tebe. Amir. Of Pekalongan. Said to have been present at the private gatherings mentioned under Albakeri. Sjech Hoesin bin Nasir.

207. Bin-Tebe (Alkathiri) Shaikh Ghalib. Born Hadramaut, Age about 50. Resident buitenzorg. About 30 years in Java. General merchant and money-lender, One of the wealthiest Arabs in that place. Business with Behn Meyer & Co. Acquaintance with Turkish and German Consuls General to and from whom he pays and receives visity openly. A regular visitor of Manggoesj's house at Soekasari (Buitenzorg) in which many of the Germans of the Marie lodge. Known as the strong hand of Manggoesj in the place. Very fiercely anti-British and actively pro-German and pro-Turkish. Al-Irsjad agent in Buitenzorg.

208. Bin-Zeidah. Shaikh Ahmad bin Saeid. Born Hadramaut. Age about 37. Money lender. Member Al-Irsjad. Franky anti-British, pro-German and pro-Turkish.

209. Bin Rabba. Shaikh Daoed bin Suliman.
Born Hadramaut. Resident Pekalongan. Member Al-Irsjad. Pro-German,
pro-Turkish and anti-British.

210. Bin Rabba. Shaikh Oemar bin Suliman.
Born Batavia. Age about 25. Resident Pekalongan Educated in Al-
Irsjad school Batavia. Now teacher that school Pekalongan.
Actively pro-German and fierely anti-British.
Additional info: Said to have been present at the private
gatherings mentioned under Albakeri. Sjech Hoesin bin Nasir.

211. Bin-Rabba. Shaikh Saleh bin Awad.
Born Hadramaut. Resident Tegal, Java. Member Ai. Extremely anti-
British, pro-German, and pro-Turkish.

212. Bin-Rabba. Shaikh Salim bin Awad.
Born Hadramaut. Resident Tegal. As dangerous as his brother Saleh
bin Awad bin-Rabba.

213. Bin-Rabba. Shaikh Salim bin Saeid bin <Shalham>
Born Hadramaut. Resident Tegal, Java. Member Al-Irsjad, Tegal.
Frankly anti-British.

214. Bin-Rabba. Suliman bin Oemar.
Born Hadramaut. Age about 50. Address Pekodjan, Batavia. Active
member Al-Irsjad. Notoriously anti-British. A most quick-tempered
man.

215. Bin-Rawas. Al Kathiri. Sheikh Badar bin Ambarak bin <Hidil>.
Born Hadramaut. Age 50. Address Meester Cornelis, Batavia. Active
member Al-Irsjad. Anti-British.

216. El Halaby. Abdul Aziz.
An Egyptian. Age 18 (he looks much older). Arrived in Java in
February 19120. To open a branch of his father's book-selling
business at Cairo. The latter business is known under the name of
Issah El Babi El Halaby & Co. The address of his father is said to
be: Issah El Babi El Halaby, P.O. Box no. 26, Gouria, Cairo.
(Revival Hall of Arabic Books).
Abdul Aziz El Halaby was educated in Syria. He resides in
Sourabaya; at first he stayed in the house of Roebaya bin Ambarak
bin-Talib, but now lives in a pension. His address is c/o Post
Restante, Sourabaya.
Abdul Aziz El Halaby is reported in one quarter to be introducing
seditious literature from Egypt. It is said that his chief client
for this class of literature are Salim bin [...] Nabahan of
Sourabaya; Shaikh Mohamad bin Salim Godjan, Abdullah bin-Afif and
Shaikh Hassan bin Salim Attamimi, all of Cheribon; also Awad Abdat
(firm of Djaffar Abdat [...] Semarang).

On the other hand, it is only fair to state that Abdul Aziz El Halaby called H/M Consulate General of Batavia to deny connection with Al-Irsjad and to say that though he advertised in that Society's journal this was done through ignorance. He produced a passport issued to him at Cairo and special letters from the Private Secretary to the High Commissioner in Egypt and from the Commandant of Police in Cairo requesting that facilities should be given to him for his journey.

220. Jawas. Shaikh Abdulrachman bin Oemar.
Born Siwoon, Hadramaut. Age about 32. Address Kebon Djeroek Batavia. Secretary of the Al-Irsjad. Earnestly occupying himself in oral propaganda against the British. Accompanies Ahmad Soerkati, director of Al-Irsjad school, on several occasions, in his travels over Java. Known as the bitterest enemy of HMS Consul General.

221. Magad. Sjech Abdullah bin Ali.
Born and resident Cheribon, Java. Motor car driver. Member Al-Irsjad Cheribon.

222. Magad. Sjech Abdullah bin Obeid.
Born Cheribon, Java. Address Koeningan near Cheribon. Member Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

223. Magad. Sjech Ahmad bin Awad.
Age 55. Born and resident Cheribon, Java. Sells mutton. Member Al-Irsjad Cheribon.

224. Mahajoeb. Abdullah.
Resident Sourabaya some years. Merchant in rings, scents, turbans and other fine Mecca goods. Age 50. Born Mecca. Mohammedan. Friend of Mohamad Ba-Rais bin Talib. Brother of Ahmad Mahajoeb and Mohamad Mahajoeb. Member Al-Irsjad.

225. Mahajoeb. Ahmad.
Resident Sourabaya for five months. Merchant in rings, scents, turbans and other fine Mecca goods. Age 55. Born Mecca. Mohamedan. Friend of Mohamed Ba-Rais bin Talib. Brother of Abdullah Mahajoeb and Mohamad Mahajoeb. Member of Al-Irsjad.

226. Mahajoeb. Mohamed.

Resident Sourabaya some years. Merchant in rings, scents, turbans and other fine Mecca goods. Age 45. Born Mecca. Mohamedan. Friend of Mohamed Ba-Rais bin Talib. Brother of Abdullah Mahajoeb and Ahmad Mahajoeb. Member of Al-Irsjad.

227. Manggoesj. Sjech Abdullah bin Oemar.

Born Batavia. Age about 30. Address Djatti, Weltevreden, Batavia. Never been Arabia. Looks after father's house property. As dangerous as father. Son of Shaikh Oemar bin Yoesoef Manggoesj.

228. Manggoesj. Shaikh Oemar bin Yoessoef.

Born Hadramaut. Age about 70. Address Djatti. Batavia. Owns house and land property. Founder of Al-Irsjad. Bitterest enemy of high class Arabs who call themselves Saids. Very illiterate and stubborn. Very closely adhered to Turkish and German Consuls General. Went on board as Mar-ie on her arrival in 1916 from German East Africa to distribute money among the crew. Free occupatopn give to poor Germans of house in Soekasari Buitenzorg. Politically opposed to Sultan Al-Gaiety of Makallah. Actively pro-German, pro-Turkish and fiercely anti-British. Placed on Statutory List in October 1918. An absolutely incurable enemy. Came to Java about 40 years ago. Never returned to Hadramaut. Appointed Captain of Arabs Batavia since about 15 years.

229. Marie (Alkathiri). Suleiman.

Resident Arab Quarter Sourabaya aof 6 ½ years. Bookseller Born Sultan Shaki, Hydrebad, (Deccan) Mohamedan. Arab. Six years ago had trouble in Bombay for selling seditious literature, fled to Singapore, but heard would be arrested and fled to Pekalongan Java. Trouble there for breaches of peace. After six months went Sourabaya. Once called before Assistant Resident Sourabaya for publishing libellous states re other Arabs. Printed German propaganda. Received seditious literature from Cairo. Often visited by Olsen (German) of German Firm Barmer Export Gesellschaft.

Additional information: Reporter to have given financial support to the Khilafat agitation in Java 11/8/20. Said to have enlisted the sympathy of British Indian merchants at Sourabaya for Al-Irsjad. Speaks Urdu fluently.

230. Mashabi. Shaikh Said bin Salim.

Born Hadramaut. Age about 35. Address Djatti, Weltevreden. Coffee merchant. Intimate friend of Manggoesj and Turkish Consul General. Said to have done business with Behn Meyer and Co. Known as one of the strongest pillars of the Al-Irsjad. Very strongly pro-German, pro-Turkish, and anti-British. An enemy as notorious and dangerous as Manggoesj.

231. Nabahan. Achmad bin Saüd bin.

Resident Sourabaya for 10 years. Bookseller. Age 25. Mohamedan. Brother of Salim bin Saüd bin Nabahan. Printing German propaganda and received seditious literature from Cairo.

232. Nabahan. Salim bin Saüd bin.
Resident Sourabaya for 18 years. Bookseller. Age 40. Mohameddan.
Brother Achmad bin Saüd bin Nabahan. Printing German propaganda
and receives seditious literature from Cairo.
Additional info: Said to be a client of Abdul Aziz El Halaby of
Sourabaya importer of seditious literature from Cairo.

233. Moor. Shaikh Mohamed.
Born Sudan. Age about 30. Address Djatti, Weltevreden (Batavia).
Teacher Al-Irsjad school Batavia.

234. Oebir. Shaikh Saeid bin Salim.
Born Hadramaut. Age 45. Address Cheribon, Java. General trader.
Member Al-Irsjad, Cheribon.

235. Oergoebi. Sjech Saeid bin Mohamad.
Born and Resident Pekalongan. Wealthy. Supporter of Al-Irsjad.
Equally as notorious as his brother Salim bin Mohammad Oergoebi,
in anti-British and pro-German and pro-Turkish activities.

236. Oergoebi. Sjech Saleh bin Mohamad.
Born and resident Pekalongan. As mischievous as his brother Salim
bin Mohamad Oergoebi.

237. Oergoebi. Sjech Salim bin Mohamad.
Born and resident Pekalongan. One of wealthiest Arabs in the
place. Strong supporter of Al-Irsjad. Business with Behn Meyer,
Semarang. Several Germans from Semarang often visit his house.
Extremely anti-British and actively pro-Turkish and pro-German.

238. Shawashi. Said Mohamad Saleh.
Born Badja Tunis. Age about 37. Resident Sourabaya. Speaks very
little French. Highly educated. A good Arabic writer and fluent
speaker. Been in Constantinople before coming to Java in October
1912 to sell Turkish Government Loans. Member of the Union and
Progress. Founder of Tentera Kandjeng Nabi Mohamad. Well known for

239. Soerkati. Shaikh Ahmad Sinnari.
Born in Sudan. Been Mecca since childhood. Age about 40. Address
Djatti, Weltevreden, Batavia.
Came to Java in 1912 to teach in the school of Djamiat Geir but
soon was requested to resign on account of intimacy with
Manggoesj. Became Principal of Al-Irsjad school at Batavia. Now
Inspector of Al-Irsjad schools in Java. Actively pro-German and
pro-Turkish and extremely anti-British. Sacrifices time and brains
for the purpose of attacking Saids and of damaging British
interests. Continually writes seditious pamphlets. Manggoesj's
most useful hand.

240. Somali. Säüd.

Negro. Born Hadramaut. Slave of the Sultan of Siwoon, Hadramaut. Age 51, money-lender. Fiercely anti-British. One of the several anti-British Arabs who frankly accuse the Saids of having sold the Hadramaut to the British Government.
